Event Terms and Conditions (2025) **British Association of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons (BAAPS)**

1. Introduction

1.1 Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before completing your booking, as described in Clauses 2.1.1 and 2.1.2 below ("Booking"). Particular attention is drawn to Clause 4.1 (Cancellation by You) and Clause 5 (Liability). We recommend you print a copy for future reference.

1.2 These Terms and Conditions, together with any terms stated on the Booking Form (collectively, the "Ticket Terms and Conditions"), govern the agreement between BAAPS ("we", "us", or "our") and the individual completing the booking ("you" or "your") for attendance at the event, exhibition, conference, or dinner specified in the Booking Form ("Event"), whether in-person or virtual.

1.3 If you purchase tickets on behalf of other delegates ("Delegates"), you agree to ensure that all such Delegates are bound by and comply with these Ticket Terms and Conditions.

1.4 In the event of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and the Booking Form, these Ticket Terms and Conditions shall prevail.

2. Booking and Payment

2.1 Tickets must be purchased online.

2.2 Bookings must be made via the relevant Booking Form on our website.

2.3 You are responsible for ensuring all information on the Booking Form, including contact details, is accurate.

2.4 Submission of a Booking Form constitutes an offer to attend the Event and is subject to these Ticket Terms and Conditions, to the exclusion of any other terms.

2.5 Fees (plus VAT where applicable) must be paid via credit/debit card or invoice, as specified on the Booking Form.

2.6 Where invoiced, payment is due immediately upon receipt and must be received before the Event.

2.7 The ticket Fee covers Event entry only and excludes travel, accommodation, insurance, or additional costs.

2.8 Fees must be paid in full, without deductions or set-off unless legally required.

3. Attendance at the Event

3.1 Compliance

While attending the Event, you and your Delegates must comply with:

- All applicable laws and health and safety regulations;
- All instructions from organisers or venue staff;
- Venue terms and conditions;
- For clinical events: Attendees must be qualified plastic surgeons or trainees, registered with the GMC or equivalent. No access is granted to non-medical professionals.

3.2 Safety and Security

You are responsible for your own safety. You must follow all safety and COVID-related protocols. Breach of these may result in removal from the Event.

3.3 Photography and Filming

We may photograph, record or broadcast the Event. Unless you notify us in writing at least 48 hours before the Event (via secretariat@baaps.org.uk), you consent to the use of your image, voice, or contribution for promotional purposes.

Personal data from such media will be processed in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#). Attendees are not permitted to photograph or record the Event without prior written approval.

3.8 Digital Events

Clauses 3.8 to 3.17 apply to Events accessed online via the BAAPS website.

You must ensure secure, individual logins are used only by registered Delegates. Passwords must not be shared.

Access to digital content is provided with reasonable care, but availability cannot be guaranteed. You are responsible for your own internet access and digital setup.

3.9 Content Use

Content is for internal business use only by registered Delegates. It must not be shared externally without permission.

You must not use Content:

- To compete with our services;
- In breach of intellectual property or data protection laws;
- For commercial exploitation;
- Or modify, copy, or reverse-engineer any part of it.

Content remains our intellectual property or that of our partners/licensors.

Content is for general informational purposes only and should not be treated as professional advice.

4. Amendments, Cancellations, and Postponement

4.1 Cancellation by You

You may cancel with a full refund if notice is given at least **72 hours** before the Event. Cancellations with less notice are non-refundable.

4.2 Amendments by Us

We may amend Event timing, content, venue (within reasonable distance), or switch from in-person to digital delivery without liability or refund.

4.3 Events Outside Our Control

We are not liable for cancellations or delays due to circumstances beyond our control, including natural disasters, strikes, pandemics, or technology failures. In such cases, we will aim to reschedule, and your booking will carry over.

4.4 Other Cancellations

If we cancel the Event for any other reason or if you are ineligible to attend, we will issue a refund. This refund is your sole remedy.

5. Liability

5.1 All warranties implied by law are excluded, as permitted.

5.2 Nothing limits our liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence or fraud.

5.3 We are not liable for:

- Loss of profit, business, or opportunity;
- Data loss or corruption;
- Indirect, consequential, or economic loss;
- Errors or delays in Content delivery.

5.4 Speaker views are their own. We are not liable for any advice or information provided during the Event.

5.5 Our total liability is limited to the amount of the Event Fee paid by you.

5.6 You agree to indemnify us for any loss arising from breach of these Terms by you or your Delegates.

5.7 If you book on behalf of an organisation, both you and the organisation are jointly liable.

6. Anti-Bribery

6.1 We comply with UK anti-bribery legislation and our own internal policies, available upon request.

7.1 We will handle personal data according to our [Privacy Policy](#). You must share this with Delegates whose data you provide.

7.2 Anyone completing the Booking Form on behalf of another confirms they are authorised to do so.

8. Miscellaneous

8.1 Entire Agreement

These Terms (alongside our Website Terms and Privacy Policy) represent the full agreement between us.

8.2 Assignment

We may assign our rights or obligations; you may not do so without written consent.

8.3 Third Parties

No third party shall have any rights to enforce these Terms under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.

8.4 Waiver

Any delay in exercising rights does not waive those rights.

8.5 Severance

If any clause is found unenforceable, it shall be removed or amended without affecting the remaining Terms.

9. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

9.1 These Terms are governed by English law.

9.2 Disputes shall be resolved in the courts of England and Wales. Consumers in Scotland or Northern Ireland may bring proceedings in their local courts.

10. Age Restriction

10.1 BAAPS Events are corporate events and attendance is restricted to individuals aged **18 and over**. Valid photo ID may be required. Entry will be refused without ID or if underage.

10.2 Events may include alcohol. Legal drinking age restrictions will be strictly enforced per local law.

11. Code of Conduct

11.1 All attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a professional, respectful, and courteous manner throughout the duration of the event/dinner. Harassment, discrimination, inappropriate behaviour, or any actions that disrupt the event or cause discomfort to other participants, staff, or vendors will not be tolerated.

11.2 The event organisers reserve the right to take appropriate action, including but not limited to removal from the event, without refund, and potential reporting to the relevant authorities or employer, depending on the nature of the behaviour.
